KUNA DE WARGANDI TERRITORY
RESOLUTION No. 001
October 19, 2025

That creates the **Kuna de Wargandí International Services Authority (KUNAISA)**, in accordance with the following provisions:

In the exercise of its constitutional and legal powers,

CONSIDERING:

That Law 34 of July 25, 2000, creates the Kuna de Wargandí Territory, and that through Executive Decree 414 of October 22, 2008, the Administrative Organic Charter of the Kuna de Wargandí Territory was adopted.

That Articles 88, 90, and 127 of the Political Constitution of the Republic of Panama recognize the general guarantees of self-determination of Indigenous peoples, in accordance with the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (UNDRIP) of September 13, 2007.

That the General Congress, duly empowered under Article 12 of its Organic Charter, considers it necessary to establish measures to contribute to the progress and development of the Territory, therefore,

RESOLVES:

FIRST: To **APPROVE** the creation of the Kuna de Wargandí International Services Authority, better known as **KUNAISA**, as an autonomous body of the Territory, with administrative, economic, technical, and financial independence. This Authority shall have legal personality through the establishment of a corporation named KUNAISA Inc., formed as a Territory-private partnership, to be registered in the Public Registry of the Republic of Panama.

SECOND: To **AUTHORIZE** KUNAISA to perform the following functions:

- a. Issuance of licenses for international service operators and platforms in sectors such as iGaming and its derivatives; Forex and its derivatives; Crypto assets and other related activities.
- b. Supervise that license holders comply with the policies, mechanisms, and internal control procedures established by KUNAISA and local regulations.

- c. Ensure compliance with the Territory's provisions that must be followed by license holders;
- d. Apply sanctions for noncompliance with local regulations and provisions;
- e. Notify local and international agencies on matters of regulatory compliance;
- f. Enter into inter-institutional cooperation agreements with State entities and foreign counterparts;
- g. Issue amendments to the regulation of licenses approved by the General Congress.

THIRD: To **ESTABLISH** the administrative structure of KUNAISA as follows:

- a. Board of Directors of KUNAISA INC
- b. Resident Agent of KUNAISA INC
- c. Technical Committee of KUNAISA
- d. Commercial Committee of KUNAISA

FOURTH: To **APPOINT**, as the Commercial Committee, with exclusive character, for a renewable period of 20 years, WARGANDI INTERNATIONAL LLC, with operational offices located at Calle 50, PH Office One, Obarrio, Panama City, whose functions shall be:

- a. Communication and direct interaction with agents, brokers, and license holders;
- b. Collaboration and reporting to KUNAISA INC;
- c. Carrying out promotion, marketing, and sales activities for the services offered by KUNAISA;
- d. International promotion of the culture and native products of the Kuna de Wargandí;
- e. Establishing mechanisms and procedures for continuous training for agents, brokers, and license holders;
- f. Signing cooperation agreements with the local and international private sector;
- g. Collecting and managing payments for sales and annual renewals of KUNAISA's services;
- h. Supporting and redistributing payments to KUNAISA, according to the approved rate schedule;
- i. Performing other related functions according to amendments issued by KUNAISA.

FIFTH: To **CONFIRM** that during the Ordinary General Congress of December 2025, resolutions shall be issued approving the regulatory framework for the issuance of licenses under KUNAISA. From the date of entry into force of the aforementioned regulatory framework, KUNAISA may issue licenses and carry out the activities for which it was created.

SIXTH: To **DECLARE** that this Resolution shall enter into force as of today's date, and that the same may be published in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Panama.
